ATLANTA POLICE TO CONDUCT CRIME REDUCTION PLAN TARGETING PART 1 CRIMES

On Friday December 17, 2010, the Atlanta Police Department will be conducting a targeted enforcement detail targeting Part 1 crime offenders. The detail will begin with roll call at 4:00 p.m. at Pittman Park 950 Garibaldi St. SW Atlanta, Ga.

This will be day two of a large joint operation utilizing various APD resources and partner law enforcement agencies throughout the City. The detail will occur in areas that have been identified to have an increased occurrence of burglaries, auto thefts, and robberies.

Units participating in the detail will include Red Dog, Vice, Targeted Enforcement, License and Permits, Financial Investigations, Homeland Security, Weed and Seed, Gun and Narcotics Units, as well as SWAT, Motorcycle units, the Fugitive Unit and Auto Theft Task Force. The Georgia State Patrol, Georgia State University P.D., Georgia Tech P.D., Atlanta University Center Police Agencies, and the U.S. Marshal Service Fugitive Task Force are also working in this cooperative effort.

The goal of this massive detail will be to assist the various zones in reducing Part 1 crimes, thereby improving the quality of life for residents, businesses and visitors to the City of Atlanta.

A mobile command post will be deployed at 950 Garibaldi St. where uniformed commanders will be available to provide sound opportunities for those media outlets present.
